# Advanced Alcohol & Drug (AADC) Counselor Examination

The International Certification and Reciprocity Consortium (IC&RC), the world leader in addiction-related credentialing, is proud to announce the finalization of the updated **Advanced Alcohol and Drug Counselor (AADC) examination.** This updated examination is aligned with the 2023 IC&RC AADC Job Analysis (JA).

The tentative administration date for the updated AADC examination is Tuesday, July 1st, 2025. All candidates scheduled to take the AADC examination, on or after this date, will be taking the updated examination.

While there are **no changes to the AADC domains** and only **minimal adjustments to the test blueprint**, we encourage candidates to compare the content outlines found in the two versions of the **AADC Exam Candidate Guide** to determine their preferred course of action.
